Boycott GUESS

GUESS is an international chain of fashion shops with outlets in many countries. Sadly their designs include the use of real fur, which is produced using immense cruelty to animals. GUESS also trades under the name Marciano.

To provide fur for companies such as GUESS, many millions of wild animals are forced to spend their entire lives crammed into tiny wire mesh cages on fur factory farms. After a lifetime of torture and misery, these animals suffering a lingering and painful death from gassing or electrocution, before having their coats ripped from their backs to supply shops such as Guess. Other animals are trapped in the wild in vicious steel jawed leg-hold traps, and often spend hours or even days in agony until the trapper returns. Some even chew off their own limbs in a desperate effort to escape the terrible suffering.

These practices are barbaric and unnecessary, and an increasing number designers and fashion shops shunning the cruelty of the fur trade and going fur free. GUESS could easily continue to trade without contributing to the cruel fur trade, please help us to persuade GUESS to take the compassionate decision to go fur-free.

Don't buy anything from GUESS or Marciano stores until they stop the use of real fur.
